Please be assured that the Government recognises the importance of providing the right support to people with disabilities of any kind. That is why the Government has committed to publishing a Green Paper on social care this summer, setting out proposals for the reform of adult social care. We are also taking forward a programme of work, focussed on working-age adults with care needs.

I understand that you recently met officials from the Department for Work and Pensions to discuss the work of Hft, and I would encourage you to continue liaising with them.
