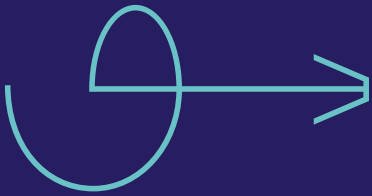

About Hft Ironbridge

From this...

Learning disabled adults have been living on and supported at our site in Ironbridge since the 1980s. It was a residential care setting in a campus-style site, with little opportunity for people to grow in independence. Homes were dated and clustered together, separate from the local community.

To this...

We teamed up with Lioncourt Homes to ensure that more people have the option to be supported within their local community. With a key to their own front door and access to all that the local community has to offer. So that learning disabled adults can live their lives with choice and control. And with as much independence as possible.

Lioncourt are building 80 new homes on this site, 12 of which are dedicated to learning disabled adults.

People can choose from bungalows and two-storey homes. Whatever works best for you now and into the future.

The majority of learning disabled adults supported here in Ironbridge for many years have chosen to stay and move into the new purpose-built homes. They have played an integral role in the planning, build and interior design.

Each of the 12 homes have been future proofed to allow integration of personalised technology, and are fully adaptable and sustainable for learning disabled adults.

Every bedroom has an en-suite and each home has shared communal spaces, kitchens, private gardens and parking.

Our exciting new development focuses on community living, where individuals will still benefit from person-centred support but with full access to their local community. Sharing their skills, talent and friendship with others living on the estate and the wider community.

Our new development lies within the Borough of Telford and Wrekin. Ironbridge is a World Heritage Site offering culture and history at every turn, including 10 fascinating museums.

Ironbridge is also home to an array of quirky independent shops, a craft centre and a great selection of tea rooms, restaurants and pubs for local residents and visitors to enjoy.

Location and getting around

The site is located within a 10-minute walk from the town centre and easily accessible by car or on foot.

Located in the heart of Shropshire, the town of Ironbridge is easily accessible by car or public transport. There are plenty of car parks and the main bus operator, Arriva Midlands, offers travel in and around the area. The nearest train station is Telford Central which again can be accessed via public transport and car.

Last few spaces available

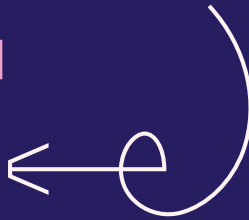
As people move into their new homes they are keen to welcome new friends to the estate.
